Founded in September 2012, the St Paul's Choir School program is based on the idea that all children are able to sing, given encouragement and instruction. We offer tuition-free music education and performance opportunities for girls and boys, ages five through high school. We are a unique after-school program that offers professional choral training, voice and piano lessons, music theory, leadership development, and mentoring to children. Each chorister receives individualized attention in a dynamic, creative, structured, and hands-on setting from caring teachers who are accomplished professionals in their areas of instruction. ## **HIGHLIGHTS OF SPRING 2023**

### **COLLEGE**

Our graduates are attending schools around the country, including William Paterson University, St. Peter's University, Monroe College, and the United States Military Academy at West Point. Our chorister Lilly just earned her degree at McGill University and will begin her master's degree in composition at Yale this fall.

## **WEDNESDAY GATHERINGS**

We gathered on Wednesdays for music lessons and choir rehearsals. The choristers worked hard on new repertoire and new skills that develop their musical knowledge and expertise as well as building solid community relationships. We also worked on memorizing prayers and scriptures, including the Lord's Prayer, Psalms, and the Choristers' Prayer (see page one).



## **HIGHLIGHTS**

- On February 15, Choir School Sunday we sang Children of the Rainbow by Rosephanye Powell, an African-American composer and a graduate of Westminster Choir College, and Joshua Fought the Battle of Jericho arranged by Craig Curry.
- On Ash Wednesday we sang Lenten Love Song by Helen Kemp.
- On March 15, Choir School Sunday, we sang Lenten Love Song and Al Shlosha d'varim by Allan Naplin.
- On Wednesday in Holy Week we sang Tenebrae as well as O pastor animarum by the poet, composer, and mystic Hildegard von Bingen.
- We led the music at the Great Vigil of Easter, and sang Barry Rose's Risen Lord
- On April 16, Choir School Sunday, we played Aaron Copland's arrangement of Simple Gifts, with Alexandra singing and Dahlia playing recorder for the prelude.
- On May 21, Choir School Sunday, we sang Children of the Rainbow and added percussion instruments, we sang Ken Medema's Tree Song with ASL signs, and Dahlia sang At the River by Aaron Copland at Communion.


